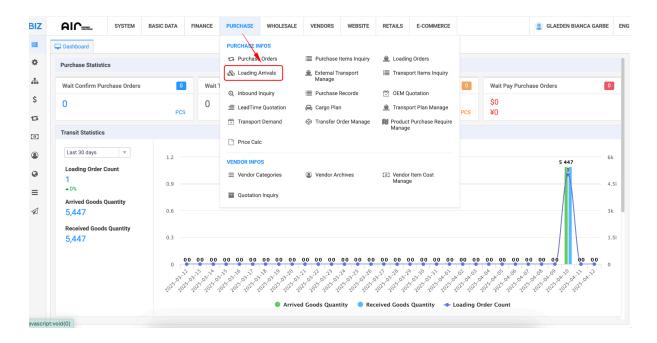
Purchase - Loading Arrivals

The **Loading Arrivals** tab is designed to give your logistics, warehouse, and supply chain teams a detailed view of incoming shipments. It consolidates container-level and order-level information so you can monitor arrival statuses, estimated timelines, shipment volumes, and trade details—all in one place.

Navigation

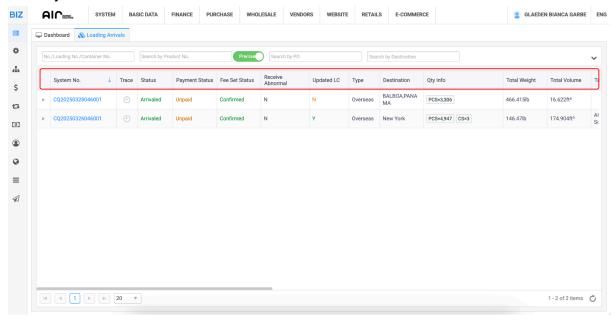
To access the Loading Arrivals tab:



- 1. Log in to your ERP System.
- 2. Navigate to the **Logistics** or **Shipping Module**.
- 3. Click on **Loading Arrivals** in the navigation menu.

Core Fields in Loading Arrivals

The tab provides a comprehensive view of all shipments that are en route or have recently arrived at their destination.



Shipment Overview:

- **System No.** Unique identifier for the arrival record.
- Trace Track the shipment's progress and status updates.
- Status Current status (e.g., In Transit, Arrived, Delayed).
- Payment Status Indicates whether associated costs have been settled.
- **Fee Set Status** Shows whether logistics-related fees (e.g., freight, duties) are configured.
- Receive Abnormal Flags any abnormal receipt conditions.
- Updated LC Indicates if Letter of Credit details were updated.
- **Type** Shipment type (e.g., Transfer, Booking, Online Return).

Destination & Shipment Details:

- Destination Final delivery point or warehouse.
- **Qty Info** Quantity of goods in this shipment.

- **Total Weight** Combined weight of the shipment.
- **Total Volume** Total volume occupied (in m³ or other units).

Target & Trade Details:

- Target Corp Receiving corporate entity.
- Target WH Warehouse assigned for receiving.
- Trade Type E-Commerce, Normal, Exclusive, etc.

Reference & Tracking Details:

- Loading Order No. Reference to the original loading order.
- Container No. ID of the shipping container.
- **Exclusive Order** Internal or project-specific order reference.
- **Transfer No.** Number tied to internal transfers.
- **TT (Days)** Transit time in days.

Timeline Milestones:

- Expected Loading Date Date the shipment was expected to be loaded.
- ETD (Estimated Time of Departure) When the shipment left its origin.
- ETA (Estimated Time of Arrival) Expected date of arrival at the destination.
- **Arrived Date** Actual date the shipment arrived.

Administrative Info:

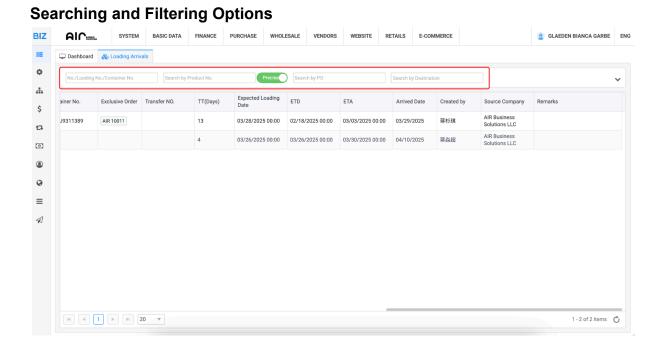
- **Created by** User who created the entry.
- **Source Company** The company or entity shipping the goods.

Remarks – Notes, issues, or observations added by users.

Available Actions in Loading Arrivals

Users can perform the following actions directly from the **Loading Arrivals** tab:

- Arrived
- Set Fees
- Change Contain Info
- Set Fee Status To
- View Fee
- Print Loading Order (PDF)
- Export Loading Order (Excel)
- Refresh



To streamline your workflow, use these filters to locate shipments:

- Number / Loading Number / Container Number Search using any of these shipment identifiers.
- Search by Product Number Filter records by product SKU.
- **Precise** Enable exact-match filtering for specific queries.
- **Search by PO** Filter by related Purchase Order number.
- **Search by Destination** Narrow results to specific delivery locations.
